Sabhayogam and Vedic Education

- Sree Raghavapuram Sabhayogam with its HQ at Cheruthazham in Perinchelloor, Kerala is one among the dharmic councils in ancient Kerala (known as Sabhayogams).
- There were 64 gramams in Kerala where vedadhayana was flourished with its unique oral tradition. Karma Kanda was given at most importance and Jnana Kanda was equally promoted.
- Due to socio-political and economic reasons, there was an unimaginable decline for vedic dharma in last century. **In Kerala, number of Gurukula patasalas got reduced from 1000s to less than 10.**
- It's the duty of each individual in Bharatha Varsha **to safe-guard this divine priceless cultural asset of India called Vedas.**
- Sree Raghavapuram Sabhayogam considers it as its foremost responsibility to flourish Vedadhyayana.
- To realize this aim, **Sabhayogam started a department Veda Vidya Prathishtanam in 2018.**



Vision and Mission – Veda Vidya Prathishtanam

- ❖ Sree Raghavapuram Sabhayogam Veda Vidya Prathishatanam plans to establish **at least two new vedic schools every year** for giving elementary vedic education of 6 years.
- ❖ It is envisaged that within a few years every eligible interested student would be trained in a vedic school.
- ❖ There will be opportunity for **higher learning in brahmanas, vedangas and sastras** for 6 years with special attention to Karma Kanda.
- ❖ Sabhayogam Veda Vidya Prathishatanam would like to emerge as a **premier in vedic education** with its centers of excellence for higher learning in Kerala and other parts of India.
- ❖ Veda Vidya Prathishatanam will start veda patasalas and promote vedic study initiatives in identified areas where there is decline of Vedic dharma, **in line with national education policy.**

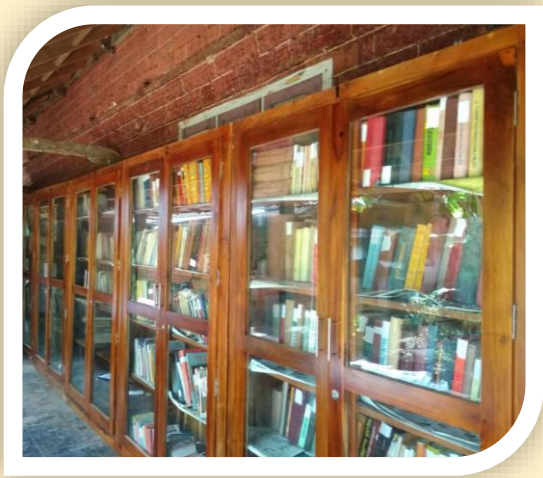

Plan for 2022

1. Sama Veda Patasala at Kurichithanam, Kottayam.

Patasala for Jaimineeya Samaveda Samhitha - Kerala dialect - for which only 2 scholars remain in the world.

2. Tantra Patasala at Kannisseri Kavu, Cheruthazham, Kannur.

Patasala for Vaidika Samayachara Paddhathi - the unique tradition of Kerala.

3. Yajurveda Patasala at Thiruvalla, Pathanamthitta

Patasala with 3 sub-centers in 3 nearby villages. Here part time elementary education in Yajurveda and Grihya soothras will be given to children as well as elders.



Budget - Sabhayogam Veda Vidya Prathishtanam

❖ Expense Heads - Honorarium, Provision, Maintenance, Schooling etc

- **Expenditure per month per Patasala – Rs. 75000/-**
 - Honorarium - Acharya – Rs. 25000/-
 - Salary - Cook cum Caretaker – Rs. 15000/-
 - Provision – Rs. 20000/-
 - Electricity, WIFI, Gas, Paper, Maintenance etc – Rs. 7500/-
 - Modern Education – Rs. 7500/-
- **Expense per year per Patasala – Rs. 9 Lakh**
- Currently there are 4 patasalas.
- Planning to start 3 patasalas this year based on fund realization.
- **Total budget for 2022-23 for 7 patasalas is Rs. 63 Lakh**
- **Expense for course completion (12 Years) in 1 Patasala - Rs. 108 Lakh**

❖ Sources of Income

- Current Sources
 - Small donations from parents, trust members and local well-wishers
 - Administration manpower arranged as voluntary service
- Future Sources (Expectations in addition to above)
 - **CSR fund from reputed companies**
 - **Sponsorship from philanthropists**
 - **Assistance from Cultural ministry**

CSR Eligible Activities of Sabhayogam

1. Preserve Veda, Vedic Dharma and other cultural treasures of Indian tradition such as Sanskrit, Vasthu, Music and Yoga by establishing patasalas and research centers.
2. Preserve and maintain buildings and other cultural assets of historical importance – such as manuscripts, paintings.
3. Encourage indigenous farming, forestation, water-sheds etc. to fight global warming and climate change.
4. Establish Goshalas for old cows. Enact schemes for welfare of animals, birds, butterflies etc.
5. Do charity by establishing hospitals, old-age homes etc. Provide medical, legal and educational help to deserved.
6. Engage in rural development activities with non-profit social motive. Establish production units, dairy units etc. employing differently abled, tribal, women and other weaker sections of the society.
7. Encourage education, research and entrepreneurship by establishing academic institutes and incubators to benefit the whole society.
8. Encourage Indigenous health systems.
